



RESIDENT FIREFIGHTER

The primary focus of a Resident Firefighter is to obtain on-the-job training to prepare for a career in the fire service.

Under the general supervision of a Company Officer, Resident Firefighters train in the general duties and responsibilities of the role. Responsibilities include participating in regular training, drills, and study activities; assisting with fire prevention and public relations; and maintaining fire stations, apparatus, and equipment. Additionally, Resident Firefighters respond to alarms, rescue, and emergency calls to protect life and property, administer emergency medical care, and perform other assigned duties.

REQUIREMENTS

- 18 Years of age
- Valid CA Driver's License
- High School Diploma or GED
- Current CPR card
- Must be actively working toward a career in emergency services or as a medical provider
- Must submit availability to work at least 2 days each month

BENEFITS

- Gain real life experience on emergency incidents and in the firehouse
- Resident stipend of \$50.00 per 24-hour shift
- Receive On-The-Job training for a career in the fire service
- Completion of Position Task Books for Firefighter and NWCG qualifications
